Assessment and Progress						
Pupils are assessed in mathematics through a combination of ongoing teacher assessment, observations, questioning, and practical activities. Assessment focuses on fluency in number, understanding of mathematical concepts, and the ability to apply skills to problem-solving and reasoning tasks. Progress is monitored against age-related expectations across the key areas of number, calculation, geometry, and measures.
